The Place is Faringdon' s community group supporting families with children under 5, funded by Faringdon Town Council and community fundraising, along with a grant from Oxfordshire County Council.

The Place are hoping to resume groups as soon as possible but in the meantime are providing telephone, text and email support during the pandemic. They really understand the demands and ups and downs of family life and sometimes a listening ear can really help. Information on other agencies who may be able to help can also be provided.

During the lockdown, some offices in the rear of the Corn Exchange have been converted so The Place have their own dedicated space ready to welcome families as soon as sessions can run again. This is an exciting step and will enable The Place to offer even more support to Faringdon families, allowing families in need to pop in. The permanent space will also allow families to access the Place more hrs a week.
