

Faringdon Country Park

Approx 1.9 miles (3km) Time: 1 hour

- Starting in The Market Place, go down Southampton Street until you reach Ferndale Street. Cross over and continue straight down a concrete path that opens into a cul-de-sac. Cross the road and continue down Southampton Street. At its end you meet a designated footpath which leads you to Volunteer Way, with a business centre and medical centre to your **R**, a playground will appear on the **L**... why not stop and have a play to entertain the children.
- Turn **L** out of the playground and then **L** onto Park Road (A417), **L** onto Palmer Road and **R** onto Clements Way.
- Keep to the **R** and follow the road until you approach the Folly Faringdon County Park car park with a welcome sign. Enter the park through the gate where you can have a walk around... and maybe bring a picnic to relax.



Return Journey

- Walk back through the gate and car park you came from, keep to the **L** onto Clements Way, turn **L** onto Palmer Road then **R** onto Park Road.
- Turn **R** onto Volunteer Way, passing the Playground, medical centre and business centre and follow back through the designated footpath which you came from which opens up onto Southampton Street.
- Cross over the road onto a cul-de-sac and continue down Southampton Street until you reach Ferndale Street. Cross over Ferndale Street onto Southampton Street and follow path back down into the Market Place.

Faringdon Cycle Park

Approx 1.7 miles (2.7km) Time: 1 hour



- Starting in The Market Place, turn **L** out of The Faringdon Information Centre/Pump House, follow the path and turn **L** up London Street. Cross over to the **R** hand-side of London Street and continue until you reach the Folly Pub, turn **R** onto Stanford Road.
- Continue up Stanford Road until after you reach Nursery View Road on the **R** and turn **R** when you get to an opening in between some trees/foliage, which will take you onto a sandy path that leads you onto the rugby field.
- Keeping to the **R**, follow the sandy path down and around the rugby field, passing a housing estate. You will eventually arrive at the Faringdon Cycle Park – it's time to go and play!

Return Journey

- Follow the same way you came or, if you have time turn **R** and why not walk all the way around the track – it's a circular route! Continue round until you reach the opening of the trees/foliage and turn **L** onto Stanford Road.
- When you reach London Street, turn **L** and follow the path back to The Market Place. Enjoy a coffee or something to eat in one of the coffee shops, restaurants, or pubs in town.

Folly Treasure hunt



Faringdon Folly Tower

Approx 1.75 miles (2.8km) Time: 40 minutes

- 1 Starting in The Market Place, turn **L** out of The Faringdon Information Centre/Pump House, follow the path and turn **L** up London Street. Cross over to the **R** hand-side of London Street and continue until you reach to the Folly Pub, turn **R** onto Stanford Road.
- 2 Keeping to the **R**, continue up Stanford Road until you pass The High House which will be on the **L**, cross over onto the other side of Stanford road where the curb is lowered for a buggy. Turn around walking back down Stanford Road and turn **R** up a hill which will be signposted to the Folly.
- 3 Continue up the path until the top of the hill where there will be a Folly map. (You will find a bench halfway up if you need a rest). Follow the path **L** or **R** around the Woods which is a circular walk or continue straight across through the woods which will take you to the Folly Tower.



Return Journey

- 1 From the Folly map, follow the path back down the hill which you came and turn **L** at the end onto Stanford Road.
- 2 Continue past The High House on your **L** and cross over onto the other side of Stanford road where the curb is lowered for a buggy. When you reach London Street, turn **L** and follow the path back to The Market Place.
