

Sally's Summary

Planning & Highways Committee 27th March 2023

A resident expressed concern regarding the standard of road surface being left by the Gigaclear installation. Residents should report any concerns regarding this to Oxfordshire County Council (OCC). The matter will be added to the next Traffic Advisory Committee Agenda to take place on 12th June at 10am in Faringdon Town Council (FTC) offices.

Five Planning Applications were considered. No Objections were registered for four. Strong Objections were registered to P22/V0996/RM (Reserved Matters) Amendment: No. 2 South of Steeds Farm Coxwell Road Faringdon. The reserved matters application was subsequently rejected at Vale of White Horse Planning Committee on 18th April 2023. Details of the FTC objections can be found on our website.

Full Council Meeting 3rd April 2023

A representative of **Faringdon Netball Club (FNC)** reported the club has seen a huge increase in membership from their foundation in 2009 but they are currently facing frustrating issues around finding regular suitable training facilities which is limiting their ability to train and expand. FTC will investigate ways they can help, including the use of s106 funding to improve the courts at Faringdon Community College. FNC itself will contact the new primary school to see if they have any suitable facilities that they might share.

Thames Valley Police (TVP) Police & Crime Commissioner, Matthew Barber, attended the meeting and gave a verbal report and update on local policing. Mr Barber outlined an increase in local police numbers as well as answering questions about the proposed future move of the police to the fire station in Faringdon and the future possibilities for the original police station site, neither of which yet have any dates. Mr Barber agreed to ensure that a regular report is sent to FTC with local crime and police activity statistics.

Faringdon Community Bus can no longer facilitate the **proposed tourist circular bus**. The Clerk has been in touch with Stagecoach and Barnes Coaches and is working to ensure the project can still take place this summer.

A **vote of thanks** from FTC to D/Cllr. Grant and D/Cllr. Thomas for all their effective hard work on behalf of the town of Faringdon, including their quick responses to concerns.

Members received a report on **Faringdon Pink Plaques**. Five pink plaques have been designed and will hopefully be sited in May. Listed Building Consent for two plaques is outstanding.

- Bangers and Beer Festival for room hire costs for festival to be held 6th – 7th October 2023

Further information was requested from Clean Slate: applying for £1,000 towards operational costs supporting victims of domestic abuse in Faringdon.

Finance and Audit 17th April 2023

End of year accounts, asset register and reserves were received. An **internal audit report** was presented with no recommendations. The Clerk was congratulated on the effective financial management of the council.

A budget of £2,500 was allocated to celebrate the beginning of a new twinning partnership with Königstein im Taunus, Germany. Our German friends will be visiting Faringdon 30th June to 3rd July.

It was agreed, in principle, to a recommendation to fund 50% of costs to make the London Street end of **Swan Lane one way**, subject to financial negotiations with OCC to match fund half the cost.
