7/2/23 Applications for financial assistance

- a) FollyFest: applying for £3,500 + £1200 room hire towards cost of FollyFest: 7th – 9th July 2023. It was PROPOSED to grant the full amount. This was SECONDED and RESOLVED.
- b) Oxfordshire Play Association for Youth Club: applying for £5,000 towards cost of a weekly youth club on Tuesday evenings at Faringdon Cricket Club from April 2023 to March 2024. It was PROPOSED to grant the full amount. This was SECONDED and RESOLVED.
- c) Clean Slate: applying for £1,000 towards operational costs supporting victims of domestic abuse in Faringdon. It was PROPOSED that this application be deferred, and the organisation be invited to present o the next grants meeting as there were several questions with regards costs for residents needing the service and activity in Faringdon. This was SECONDED and RESOLVED.
- d) Bangers and Beer Festival: applying for room hire costs of a Bangers and Beer festival to be held 6th – 7th October 2023. It was PROPOSED to grant in full. This was SECONDED and RESOLVED.

8/2/23 Pink Plaques Grant

9/2/23 Grant Policy
