

Sally's Summary - Your Town Clerk, Sally Thurston, summarises this month's meetings below. Full

Planning and Highways 26th June 2023

Cllr. Norris was elected as **Vice Chair** for the Planning and Highways Committee.

A resident asked about **parking enforcement in Church Street** and surrounding streets after experiencing long term problems with illegal parking outside their property. FTC have no powers to enforce parking but will raise the matter with Oxfordshire County Council (OCC).

Three planning applications were considered with **no objections** registered. Full details can be found in the meeting minutes on our website.

A review of the **Faringdon Neighbourhood Plan (FNP)** will be considered after a strategic plan for FTC is developed.

It was agreed to proceed with the purchase of a small section of land for pedestrian access across a ransom strip for £1 in order to create a footpath between Fernham Road and Fernhill Gardens.

A **Retail Park / Folly Park** Bridge is being investigated further, in partnership with OCC, with the hope of creating safe access using available s106 funds.

It was agreed to support proposed **Traffic Orders for Parking in the Town Centre** but to request the stretches of parking along Church Street be extended from 30 mins to 1 hour.

Data from Speed Indicator Devices (SID) was reviewed. The data suggests that the SIDs are working in terms of reducing the speed of cars.

Cllr. Ford will represent FTC at a Vale Planning Surgery in July to discuss **pre-planning and safe crossing of A420**

Full Council 10th July 2023

A presentation was given by **Faringdon Pétanque Club** who are proposing to create a Pétanque piste. They enquired about space at Tucker Park. It was advised they talk to the Tucker Recreational Trust at their meeting in September.

The successful visit for our friends from **Konigstein** was reported which included the signing of the twinning treaty, which will be available to view in the FTC office

shortly. Members of the community are encouraged to get involved in the twinning partnership. The **next visit to Konigstein will be in December** to experience the Christmas markets. Please email the twinning association on konigsteinfaringdon@gmail.com for more details.

County Cllr. Thomas shared the welcome news

that a new regular **X35 direct bus service between** Faringdon and Didcot starts at the end of July 2023.

It was agreed that, to tackle **town centre regeneration**, the next town meeting, on 6th November 2023, will be a meeting of Faringdon businesses to outline their aspirations and needs.

FTC will support an application for developer funding from the district council to install **floodlights at Tucker Park.**

Finance and Audit Committee 17th July 2023

Cllr. Finn was elected Vice Chair.

It was agreed that FTC employ a part-time, 10 hours per week, **Manager post for the Food Bank**, for an initial 2-year term, to be reviewed after 12 months. Funding of £6,000 per annum for the post will be provided by the charity.

Grants Sub Committee 17th July 2023

Cllr. Finn was elected as Chair and Wild as Vice Chair of the Grants Sub-Committee.

The following grants were awarded:

- £3,000 towards maintenance of the Folly Tower woodland.
- £1684 towards running costs of Bromsgrove Day Centre
- £500 from the Town Centre Regeneration s106 earmarked reserve towards planting in Southampton Street Carpark
- £2,000 towards running costs of Faringdon Netball Club If your organisation needs financial assistance, please visit our website for details of how to apply the next deadline is Friday 20th October 2023.

Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL)

August Artist of the month

Faringdon Information Centre is excited to welcome Jan Fennelly as our August Artist of the month. Jan's work

explores the colours and textures of this beautiful, light-filled media. She has always loved glass; no other substance has the same ability to transmit and reflect light and colour the way glass does. Jan started working with glass by making leaded glass panels about 20



years ago. Then 10 years ago she was lucky enough to have a studio built in the garden, which enabled her to get a kiln so she could also experiment with fused glass. This opened

whole new avenues of possibilities – Jan doesn't believe that she will ever stop being excited by learning about and making glass art. No two pieces ever turn out the same, each is unique. Currently, Jan is creating decorative fused bowls using powdered and sheet glass to



explore colours, patterns and texture. Glass, like no other media, allows the reflection and transmission of light, enhancing the vibrant colours. Before retiring Jan worked as a research scientist, now she experiments in glass - the possibilities are endless.
