TUCKER'S RECREATION GROUND TRUST Reg. Charity No. 300156

Charitable Objectives

- The provision and maintenance of a recreation ground for the benefit of the inhabitants of the parish of Great Faringdon without distinction of political, religious or other opinions, with the object of improving the conditions of life for said inhabitants.
- 2. The land belonging the charity (known as Tucker Park) shall be held in trust for use for the object of the charity.

Terms of Reference

Faringdon Town Council acts as the Sole Trustee of Tucker's Recreation Ground Trust

Management Committee: All Town Council Members

Committee Quorum: 5

Adopted by Trust: 2nd June 2021

- The Trust will seek to meet the charitable objectives of Tucker's Recreation Ground Trust and will be responsible for managing Tucker Park for the benefit of Faringdon.
- 2. The Trust will hold an annual general meeting where a chair will be appointed and at least two further meetings per annum.
- 3. The Trust shall keep minutes, in books, of the proceedings of its meetings.
- 4. The Trust will appoint a Responsible Financial Officer who will keep:
 - Accounting records for the charity
 - Prepare annual accounts for the charity and submit to the charity commission
- 5. The Trust may co-opt 2 non-voting members.
- 6. The Trust will ensure all health and safety requirements are met.
- 7. The Trust will set an annual budget and monitor its financial performance against the budget.
- 8. Should the Trust cease to exist, funds will be transferred to Faringdon Town Council for the management of open spaces in the town.
- The Trust has a duty to consider the long-term environmental impacts of its decisions and take steps to reduce FTC's carbon footprint and promote sustainability.
