

TRAFFIC REGULATION NOTICE

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, that the Oxfordshire County Council

TEMPORARILY PROHIBITS THE USE OF AND WAITING ON THE HIGHWAY BY ALL MOTOR VEHICLES

LOCATION: East Hanney, A338 Crown Meadow (between Steventon

Road and Anderson Place)

REASON: To facilitate carriageway patching

DURATION: Starting on 14 August 2024

The anticipated completion date is 15 August 2024 (date included). This will operate between 08:00 and 17:00

(Traffic Regulation Notices cover a maximum of 5

consecutive days.)

ACCESS: Limited access will be maintained for emergency service

vehicles and for frontages within the closed section of road, subject to the progress of the works. Access will

be maintained for cyclists and pedestrians.

The "No Waiting" restriction means that wherever there are in place yellow "No Waiting" cones, you will not be able to park vehicles on the highway.

SUGGESTED ALTERNATIVE ROUTE: HGV's diversion via Grove A417

Mably Way, A417 Wantage Denchworth Road, A417 to Faringdon, A420 to Southmoor, A415 to Frilford and Vice

Versa.

Light A338 traffic via Hanney Road to Steventon, B4017 to Abingdon, A415 through Marcham to Frilford Lights and Vice versa.

East Hanney Main Street traffic – Via Summertown and southern entrance to Main Street and Vice versa.
