## District and County Councillor's Report: 9th September 2024

## **Local Issues:**

- <u>Lighting on Highworth Road</u> I continue to follow this up and officers have apologised for the delays.
- <u>Parking on the Apron</u> have been following up complaint of parking on the apron around the Old Town Hall.
- Damage to Bus Lane this continues to remain a problem; officers are aware.
- <u>Highways Maintenance Requests</u> I have suggested that the resurfacing of Highworth Road and Canada Lane be prioritised in the coming programme of works.
- A420 Speed Reductions the consultation has closed; I wrote in support of the proposal and continue to follow its progress; the decision will probably be taken by the Cabinet Member on October 10th.
- <u>Wicklesham Quarry</u> there is no further news on the application; it will go to committee should officers recommend approval.

<u>The Thames Valley Flood Scheme</u> - is a large-scale project looking to reduce flood risk across the Thames Valley; it is an Environment Agency scheme which may affect areas around Faringdon. Find out more using the link below with the latest update.
