## TRAFFIC REGULATION NOTICE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984,  
that the Oxfordshire County Council

**TEMPORARILY PROHIBITS THE USE OF AND WAITING ON THE HIGHWAY  
BY ALL MOTOR VEHICLES**

**LOCATION:** Coleshill, B4019 (between the entrance to Colleymore Farm and the junction with Fresden Lane)

**REASON:** To facilitate the resurfacing of the carriageway and subsequent reinstatement of all lines and road markings.

**DURATION:** Starting on 01 September 2025  
The anticipated completion date is 02 September 2025 (date included). This will operate between 07:00 and 19:00

( Traffic Regulation Notices cover a maximum of 5 consecutive days.)

**ACCESS:** Limited access will be maintained for emergency service vehicles and for frontages within the closed section of road, subject to the progress of the works. Access will be maintained for cyclists and pedestrians

The “No Waiting” restriction means that wherever there are in place yellow “No Waiting” cones, you will not be able to park vehicles on the highway.

**SUGGESTED ALTERNATIVE ROUTE:** Traffic will be diverted back up the B4019 to Faringdon, to turn south along the Coxwell Road, to turn south again onto the A420 to Watchfield, to turn west onto the B4508, to turn west onto the B4000 to Highworth, to turn back east onto the B4019 returning to Coleshill, and vice versa.
